3/20/20 Governor Cuomo has issued guidance on essential services under the “New York State on Pause” executive order: For purposes of Executive Order 202.6 “Essential Business means: Essential services necessary to maintain Safety, Sanitation, and essential operations of residences and essential business’ Number 11- BUILDING CODE ENFORCEMENT.

Municipalities’ that have ceased/stalled inspections may utilize the following Contracted services as per NYS Building Standards and Codes Technical Bulletin 19 NYCRR 1203- Last Amended August 29, 2018
19 NYCRR 1208- Last Amended August 22, 2018
Minimum Standards for Administration and Enforcement
Local Government use of contracted-for-services for part of administration and enforcement program.

General Municipal Law allowing the functions and duties of a building safety inspector/ Code Enforcement Official to be performed in all local governments that are parties to such inter-municipal agreement, so long as the building safety inspector/ Code Enforcement Official sides in one of the local governments.
